IRG-International Reintegration Grants (2-4 years)

A fixed amount of $25000 \in$ per year during the period of reintegration and up to a maximum period of 4 years ($25.000 \in *4 = 100.000 \in$)

The grant is a flat rate contribution to project costs

- Salary costs of the researcher or other staff employed for the project
- Travel costs
- Consumables
- Patent costs
- Publication costs
- Equipment (permission mandatory)

Management Activities and Contribution to Overheads are not applicable.

ERG-European Reintegration Grants (2-3 years)

A fixed amount of 15.000€ during the period of reintegration and up to a maximum period of 3 years $(15.000 \in *3 = 45.000 \in)$

The grant is a flat rate contribution to project costs

- Salary costs of the researcher or other staff employed for the project
- Travel costs
- Consumables
- Patent costs
- Publication costs
- Equipment (permission mandatory)

Management Activities and Contribution to Overheads are not applicable.





ITN-Initial Training Networks

The financial support for ITN is calculated on the basis of eligible activities and takes the form of grants covering up to 100% of the budget.

1. Eligible expenses for the activities carried out by the researchers

<u>Monthly living allowance (correction factor for each country)</u>

A basic amount to be paid to the researcher in monthly installments according to the table.

Monthly Mobility allowance (correction factor for each country)

- €800/month: Researcher with family obligations (mariage or relationship with equivalent status to a marriage recognized by the national legislation of the country of the host organisation or the nationality of the researcher, and/or children).
- €500/month: Researcher without family obligations

An allowance upon taking up employment and yearly thereafter. A fixed amount based upon the direct distance between the location of origin of the researcher and the location of the host institution.

Career exploratory allowance (single payment)

This allowance of a single payment of 2000€/fellow,only for stays of at least one year, is intended to enable each researcher to help develop their career

- Attending job interviews
- Additional courses
- Job affairs

Is only paid to early-stage and experienced researchers recruited for initial training

Contribution to the participation expenses of eligible researchers

This contribution is managed by the hosting organisation for expenses related to the participation of the researchers in research and training activities

- Contribution to research-related costs
- Meetings
- Conference attendance
- Training actions

It consists of a fixed amount

- 600€ per researcher-month recruited for initial training: for laboratory based research projects
- 300€ per researcher-month for initial training: fornon-laboratory based research projects

2.Eligible Expenses for the activities carried out by the host organisations

Contribution to the research/training/transfer of knowledge programme expenses

A contribution of a fixed amount of $1.200 \notin$ per reæarcher month.

Contribution to the host organisation for the execution of the training project:

- Publication of vacant position
- Internal joint training actions
- Teaching material

Organisation of conferences, workshops and events

- Invitation of keynote speakers
- Publications
- Rental of premises
- Web casting

Contribution to the expenses related to the coordination between participants

- Network meetings
- Detachment of staff





Management activities

Maximum of a 7% of the total Community contribution for networks and a maximum of 3% for mono-partner.

Contribution to overheads

10% of direct costs except for subcontractors and the costs of the resources made available by third parties which are not used in the premises of the beneficiary.

A fixed amount of $15.000 \in$ per researcher and per year (for a maximum of 1 year) to support the reintegration of the researcher in his country of origin. The contribution is managed by the organisation hosting the researcher in the third country.
